



This September, Art League Gallery will host *Island Treasures*, an exhibit of original paintings by Hilton Head native Addison Palmer. Palmer's award-winning work focuses mainly on landscapes and animals—both wild and domestic—and largely features the beauty of the Lowcountry. His style ranges from clean-lined depictions in bold colors to serene landscapes and skiescapes using a minimal color palette.
