



In recognition of their long-standing support of both the hospital and the arts, the Beaufort Memorial Hospital Foundation has announced that Bill and Martha Harvey will serve as honorary chairmen for its 13<sup>th</sup> annual Duke Symphony Orchestra concert fundraiser, scheduled for April 9.

Bill recently completed nine years on the BMH Foundation Board, the last two as chairman, during which time he saw first-hand the vital role of Beaufort Memorial in the health and well-being of the community, and also how very much the Foundation depends on community support.
