persuasively argues that conservation of wildlife can only be successful if it generates a deep appreciation for the cultural ties that link people of all backgrounds to the natural world and its power to unite.

A native of Edgefield SC, Lanham is the author of *The Home Place: Memoirs of a Colored Man's Love Affair with Nature*, which

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received the Reed Award from the Southern Environmental Law Center and the Southern Book Prize and was a finalist for the John Burroughs Medal.
