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Local artist Kathryn Riley Parker presents *Paper Cuts*, an exhibition uniquely in the medium of paper at Art League Gallery. This theme was chosen to “show the medium’s capacity to add depth and texture” and is largely inspired by Lowcountry flora and fauna.
