Along with her frustrations about her messy home, Lane discovers she's about to lose her surgeon-husband to his 67-year old Argentinian breast cancer patient. Thrown into the mix are a loopy quest to find a healing yew tree in Alaska, an extended dirty joke told in Portuguese, and a sponge-wielding sister who finds scrubbing bathrooms therapeutic.

Offbeat humor, impromptu arias, wacky poetry and romance spice big themes of love and loss in Lean Ensemble Theater's production of Sarah Ruhl's *The Clean House*. This whimsical comedy, a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize, is directed by Lean Ensemble Theater's Blake White and features ensemble member Jenny Zmarzly along with Taylor Harvey, Karin de la Penha, Carolyn Popp, and Ryan K.
