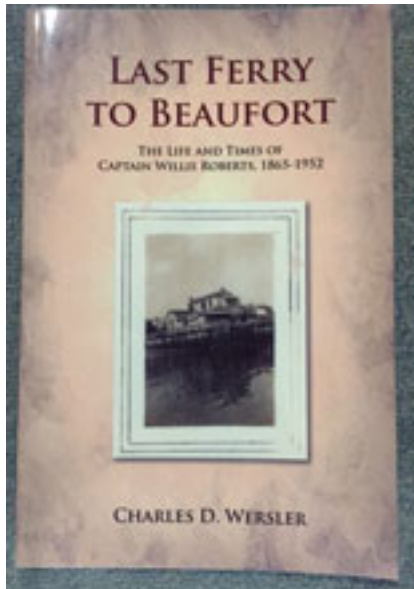


Book Signing with Two Beaufort Authors

Charles Wersler and Sandra Fischer will be signing their books at McIntosh Book Shoppe in the Bay Street Marketplace, 919 Bay Street on Saturday, February 27 from noon until 3:00 pm Mr. Wersler's book, *Last Ferry to Beaufort* is based on his study of personal photographs and historical documents concerning the last ferryman in Beaufort County, who also just happened to be his great grandfather, Captain Willie Roberts. Wersler was born in Beaufort and as a writer has a deep interest in the life and history of Beaufort

Sandra Fischer's book, *Seasons in the Garden*, is a compilation of inspirations she wrote



over a 13-year period for newsletters of the Dataw Island Garden Club. Her observations reflect how the seasons of life in both nature and humans possess many parallels.
